

HOW TO

Access the property

You can get in the front door using the keyless entry. Your code is in the message you received with check-in details for your stay. To lock it, push the lock button.

Use the laundry

The laundry room is downstairs, behind the kitchen. To start the washer or dryer, hold the start button down until it beeps. Please clean dryer's filter before each use and leave the washing machine open when not in use.

Turn on the living room TV

The smallest remote operates the TV. There are built-in Amazon and Netflix apps you can use with your account. There's also HDMI and USB-C cable to connect your device.

Use deck/balcony

You can access balcony from the living room on the second floor. Feel free to use wooden chairs (usually stored in the mud room). Please take everything inside when you don't use it or when you leave to prevent rain damage.

Use the fireplace

You can turn on the fireplace by pressing red button and top right button together. There is a line with the spark on the remote connecting the two buttons. Fireplace is ventless (not recommended to run for more than two hours in a row)

Outdoor grill

Feel free to use outdoor grill. Turn on propane tank valve to operate and please turn it off when you're done grilling. Please don't move it and clean after each use.

Get comfortable in the backyard

You can find pillows for chairs in the box on your left when you exit from the back door. There's also conrhole bags inside and board behind it. Please put them back when you leave.

GET AROUND THE AREA

Wilmington and West Dover have Moover bus shuttle service. There's also limited Uber and Lyft availability.

Moover

Closest stop is quarter mile away (in 5 minutes walk) at the intersection of East Dover Road and Route 100.
You can use it to get to the Mt. Snow or Wilmington (with connections to Brattleboro and Bennington)

Albany International Airport

You can take route 9 from Wilmington to Bennington, then route 7 to get there in 1.5 hours, but be sure to allow at least an extra half hour for traffic in Troy, especially if you're headed there between 4:00 PM and 7:00 PM.

Brattleboro Train Station

You can take route 9-W or VT-30 to Brattleboro Train Station and get there in 40 minutes. Or you can use Moover service with a stopover in Wilmington to get there in 1-1.5 hour.



HOW TO

Adjust temperature (1st floor)

You can adjust heating on the first floor by using propane heater in the kitchen. Please use Ecobee thermostat above it to adjust the temperature. Please set the temperature to the lowest setting when leave.

Adjust temperature (2nd floor)

Heating and cooling on the second floor controlled with the mini-split system. There's a separate unit and the remote in the living room and each bedroom. You can select heating, cooling or auto mode, and adjust temperature. Please turn them off when you leave.

Store the trash

Please use trash bags that can be found under kitchen sink. If you run out of supplies, you can buy more 13-gallon bags from the River Valley Market nearby.

We don't have regular trash pick up service in the area, so trash will be picked up by the cleaning service after your stay. Please put tied garbage bags in the big containers (one for recycling and one for the trash) in the mud room when you leave.

Use the EV charger

You can find level 2 EV charger at the frond side of the building. Please park your electric vehicle along the house, closer to the charger to avoid blocking the Bunnell Drive.

Only vehicle connected to the EV charger can use this spot. All other vehicles should park at the parking lot across Bunnell Drive.

After charging, please wrap the cable in a loop around the dedicated cable management handle near the charger and put connector into the storage slot to protect it from rain or snow.

Recycling

MIXED PAPER:

YES: Newspapers (inserts too), Junk mail (plastic wrap, pieces removed), Mixed office paper, Magazines, Books without hard covers, Envelopes (windows okay), Phone books

NO: Aseptic boxes (e.g. drink boxes, soymilk, boxed wine), Milk cartons, Tissues, Tyvek (non-tearing) envelopes, Egg cartons, Paper Towels

CARDBOARD:

YES: Corrugated cardboard (clean, dry, flattened), Brown paper bags, Boxboard (The grayish single-ply cardboard used for: Cereal boxes, Tissue boxes, Toilet paper rolls), Pantry food boxes such as crackers, pasta, etc., Soda or beer boxes/six-pack carriers)

NO: Waxed cardboard, Egg cartons,
Freezer boxes (contain wet-strength additives that make them non-recyclable),
Juice or milk cartons (contain plastic layers that makes them non-recyclable)

CONTAINERS:

YES: Glass bottles and jars, Aluminum cans, Steel (Tin) cans, Plastic bottles, lids, tubs rinsed

NO: Plastic bags (can be recycled at Hannaford's), Styrofoam, Light bulbs, Window glass, Ceramics, Pyrex, Kitchenware
